## **Conference grants to attend Science Conferences**

Would you like some money towards the cost of attending SciCon 2012 in Auckland this year?

ASTA is offering 5 grants of \$200 each to attend this science conference. Applicants for these grants may come from the Primary, Secondary or Tertiary sectors.

**We will be carrying out the draw for the grants at the AGM, on Thursday 15th March 2012**

To be in the draw you, or a colleague from your school, must be present at the AGM. Use the attached form to fax or email your application to Michele, or you can complete a form at the AGM. As in the past your school must have paid its subscription to ASTA for you to be eligible to receive the grant. If your school is not financial by 8<sup>th</sup> April we will draw again.

### **Conditions**

1. The money must make up the short fall of what your institution is able to provide ie if you are fully funded for fees, accommodation and transport costs you cannot apply.
2. You will be required to provide an oral or written report to the AGM.
3. If you received support in 2010 or 2011 this does not preclude you from applying again but if there are more than five applicants your name will not be included in the ballot.
4. If for some reason you cannot attend the conference the money must be returned. **You cannot pass the money on to somebody else.**
